OPERATIONAL REPORT

The District continued its fall surveillance program which included inspections for mosquito breeding throughout the month of November. District personnel continue to routinely inspect public areas, such as street gutters, catch basins, box drains, swimming pools, etc., for any evidence of mosquito breeding. The area(s) in which breeding was found were treated appropriately.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Public Education

The District has continued its public awareness campaign to promote public safety through effective mosquito control and shared public responsibility. Social media platforms are being updated daily with information, stories, and best practices for protecting yourself from mosquitoes. District personnel are also in the neighborhoods daily, distributing mosquito awareness literature and promoting the District's message directly to residents.

West Nile Virus

In the month of October, CCMAD had two confirmed human cases of West Nile Virus (WNV). Neither of the two resulted in fatalities. The areas in which the cases originated from have been inspected and treated multiple times during and since the month of September when the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health started reviewing the two cases. The review concluded in the month of October.

Southern Region Vector General Manager Meeting

The Southern Region Vector General Manger Meeting took place on November 12, 2025. The main update from the meeting is that there were seven new human Dengue cases in Los Angeles County. Five of the cases were isolated between two households in the city of La Puente. The remaining cases were within Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District's jurisdiction. No fatalities out of the seven confirmed cases.
