OPERATIONAL REPORT

The District continued its fall surveillance program which included inspections for mosquito breeding throughout the month of November. District personnel continue to routinely inspect public areas, such as street gutters, catch basins, box drains, swimming pools, etc., for any evidence of mosquito breeding. The area(s) in which breeding was found were treated appropriately.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Public Education

The District has continued its public awareness campaign to promote public safety through effective mosquito control and shared public responsibility. Social media platforms are being updated daily with information, stories, and best practices for protecting yourself from mosquitoes. District personnel are also in the neighborhoods daily, distributing mosquito awareness literature and promoting the District's message directly to residents.

Mosquito Control 101

In the month of November, CCMAD sent follow-up emails to all the Compton Unified School District Middle School principals that did not respond to the letters and emails that were previously sent. Davis Middle School Principal Carol Hsini and Willowbrook Middle School Principal have responded and are partnering with the district on scheduling Mosquito Control 101 classes in the spring.
