OPERATIONAL REPORT

The District’s Autumn surveillance program continued throughout the month. District personnel continue to routinely inspect public areas, such as street gutters, catch basins, box drains, swimming pools, etc., for any evidence of mosquito breeding. No breeding was found in the areas that were inspected.

MANAGER’S REPORT

Public Education

The District has continued its public awareness campaign to promote public safety through effective mosquito control and shared public responsibility. Social media platforms are being updated daily with information, stories, and best practices for protecting yourself from mosquitoes. District personnel are also in the neighborhoods daily, distributing mosquito awareness literature and promoting the District’s message directly to residents. The District has registered to participate in Compton Early College’s Career Day. This event will be held on January 31, 2025, at 2601 N. Wilmington Ave, Compton, CA 90222.

Annexation

The completed application packet was submitted to the Local Agency Formation Commission For the County of Los Angeles (LALAFCO) on 12/16/2025. Board Members of CCMAD will be informed once approved.

District Modernization Program

On October 31, 2025, the District met with LPA Inc. to finalize plans regarding improvements to the CCMAD District Office. The District is currently awaiting plans for repair and reconstruction on the Gambusia (Mosquito Fish) Pond.

Compton Creek Maintenance

Rivers Project Manager Julio Ramos of the U.S Army Corp of Engineers (USACE) stated that USACE is awaiting the decision from the Office of Council. The decision from the Office of Council will determine if the contract for removing sediment from Compton Creek will need to be reopened for bid. As of now, there is a tentative date of April,15 2025 to begin sediment removal in Compton Creek.

Voluntary Pool Reporting Program

The Voluntary Pool Reporting Program is a quick link that was added to the CCMAD website in November of 2025. This program gives CCMAD residents the opportunity to register their swimming pool, sauna, jacuzzi, or fountain with the District. Once registered, the District is then able to conduct inspections to prevent mosquito breeding.
