OPERATIONAL REPORT

The District continued its spring surveillance program which included inspections for mosquito breeding throughout the month of July. District personnel continue to routinely inspect public areas, such as street gutters, catch basins, box drains, swimming pools, etc., for any evidence of mosquito breeding. The area(s) in which breeding was found were treated appropriately. The District inspected Compton Creek for breeding in the month of August. No breeding was found in Compton Creek.

MANAGER’S REPORT

Public Education

The District has continued its public awareness campaign to promote public safety through effective mosquito control and shared public responsibility. Social media platforms are being updated daily with information, stories, and best practices for protecting yourself from mosquitoes. District personnel are also in the neighborhoods daily, distributing mosquito awareness literature and promoting the District’s message directly to residents.

West Nile Virus

On July 28, 2025, the San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District confirmed a positive case of (WNV) from mosquito samples collected in the El Monte. The San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District will continue with their efforts to eliminate mosquito breeding.

St. Louis Encephalitis Virus

On August 7, 2025, the Coachella Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District confirmed a positive test of (SLEV) from mosquito samples collected in the community of Oasis. No human cases of (SLEV) have been reported this year in the Coachella Valley or the state of California. In response to the positive mosquito samples, Coachella Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District will deploy additional mosquito control techniques. This will include but not be limited to truck mounted adulticide applications.
