OPERATIONAL REPORT

The District continued its spring surveillance program which included inspections for mosquito breeding throughout the month of July. District personnel continue to routinely inspect public areas, such as street gutters, catch basins, box drains, swimming pools, etc., for any evidence of mosquito breeding. The area(s) in which breeding was found were treated appropriately. The District inspected Compton Creek for breeding in the month of July. No breeding was found in Compton Creek.

MANAGER’S REPORT

Public Education

The District has continued its public awareness campaign to promote public safety through effective mosquito control and shared public responsibility. Social media platforms are being updated daily with information, stories, and best practices for protecting yourself from mosquitoes. District personnel are also in the neighborhoods daily, distributing mosquito awareness literature and promoting the District’s message directly to residents.

Mosquito and Vector Control Association of California (MVCAC)

The Southern Region (MVCAC) Summer Quarterly Meeting took place on July 23, 2025. The San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District has treated 1,400 pools identified as unmaintained due to the Eaton Fires. The first round of treatments with the unmaintained swimming pools took place in April and May. The second round of treatments are currently taking

place. There has been a total of 4 positive cases of Dengue (3 -San Gabriel Valley / 1 – Long Beach). All cases were travel-related cases. There are no locally acquired cases in the state of California thus far.

Pond Repair Project

During the month of July. The District has two plumbing companies inspect the drainage system for both ponds. The District is currently awaiting submissions from both companies.
