OPERATIONAL REPORT

The District's spring surveillance program began in the month of March for preparation for the beginning of mosquito breeding season. District personnel continue to routinely inspect public areas, such as street gutters, catch basins, box drains, swimming pools, etc., for any evidence of mosquito breeding. No breeding was found in the areas that were inspected.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Public Education

The District has continued its public awareness campaign to promote public safety through effective mosquito control and shared public responsibility. Social media platforms are being updated daily with information, stories, and best practices for protecting yourself from mosquitoes. District personnel are also in the neighborhoods daily, distributing mosquito awareness literature and promoting the District's message directly to residents.

Vector Control Joint Powers Association

On February 27, 2025, the General Manager for CCMAD attended the annual conference held by the Vector Control Joint Powers Association (VCJPA). Information regarding CCMAD's employees, District Building, and District Vehicle(s) insurance were discussed.

American Mosquito Control Association

The General Manager along with CCMAD Board Members attended the 91st Annual (AMCA) Conference. CCMAD's General Manager was introduced to new products and information regarding mosquito breeding prevention.

District Modernization Program

CCMAD has met with two separate pond repair companies that examined the District's Gambusia (Mosquito Fish) pond. The General Manager of CCMAD has also consulted with a plumbing company regarding repairs to the drainage system of the District Ponds. CCMAD will receive pricing estimates from both pond repair companies no later than April 4, 2025.
